

Picnic Reservation Procedure

- Picnic areas can be reserved online at pleasantonfun.com
- Only 1 rental is allowed per day
- Rental season is March through mid-November
- Parks hours are dawn to dusk year-round
- Pleasanton residents may reserve a picnic area up to one (1) year in advance
- Non-residents may reserve a picnic area up to nine (9) months in advance
- Special events in the parks may be charged additional \$1000 damage deposit.

Picnic General Rules

- 1. Alcoholic beverages are **NOT** allowed in Pleasanton Parks.
- 2. The City has adopted a ban on smoking in:
 - a. City Parks as well as pathways through the parks
 - b. Trails including arroyo trails
 - c. City parking lots adjacent to parks and recreational facilities.
- 3. Inflatable jump equipment, tarps, ponies, petting zoos, or dunk tanks are not allowed.
- 4. Barbecues are provided in picnic areas. Coals and ashes are to be left in the BBQ are not to be dumped in trash receptacles.
- 5. Portable barbecues are allowed; however, a permit from the Fire Department will be required with your rental along with a picture or diagram of the unit and location where it will be placed. To obtain a fire permit call the Fire Department at 925-454-2361.
- 6. A City of Pleasanton Business License is required of all businesses (caterers, food trucks, interactive trucks, entertainers) performing a service at an event. If necessary, contact the Business License Department at 925-931-5440.
- 7. Any food, debris, litter, trash, decorations, games etc., must be properly disposed of prior to leaving the picnic area.
- 8. Signage, posters, or banners may not be attached to any park structures, including walls, trash receptacles, columns, trees, and light posts.
- 9. Dogs are to be restrained by substantial leash not to exceed six feet in length. Persons with dogs must dispose of waste.
- 10. No amplified music/PA system is allowed in any park.
- 11. No advertising shall be exhibited, and no solicitation or sales made on the grounds of any park.
- 12. No vehicles are to be driven or parked on walkways, patios, or turf areas.
- 13. Bring your authorized Picnic Area Agreement with you on the day of your event to confirm that you reserved the designated picnic area.
- 14. Applicants may be required to provide the City of Pleasanton with a valid Certificate of Liability Insurance with the Endorsements page if your picnic falls into a "Special Event" category, i.e. is open

to the public, includes outside vendors such as gaming or entertainment trucks, or caterers.

- 15. Cancellation Policy All cancellations must be in writing, recreation@cityofpleasantonca.gov. Cancellations received at least 30 days prior to the date reserved will incur a \$50 cancellation fee. There are no refunds for rain, although you can reschedule a date within a reasonable time. Cancellations received less than 30 days prior to your reservation date will be charged 75% of the rental fee; within 10 days prior to your reservation date, 100% of the rental fee will be forfeited. Damage deposit will be fully refunded.
- 16. A RESERVED sign will be posted with your event title prior to your reservation date.
- 17. If at any time during the rental these rules are not followed it may result in the cleaning/damage deposit being forfeited.
