## MAINTAINING OUR WATER SYSTEM


Public Works Utilities Division



Operations and Maintenance Team: Our team of 27 employees maintain, repair, and monitor our water and sewer systems. Our water system includes 339 miles of pipeline, 14 booster pump stations, and 19 storage tanks.



Emergency Response: Emergency services are available 24 hours a day, 365 days a year.



Water Quality Testing: Water quality testing is done regularly to ensure our water meets and exceeds standards.



Water Meter Repair: The City maintains approximately 22,000 water meters. Currently, the City is replacing an average of 250 meters each month.



Backflow Inspection & Maintenance: Devices are regularly inspected and repaired to prevent backflows into the water system.



Fire Hydrant Testing & Maintenance: The City regularly tests and maintains 3,500 water hyrdants.



Water Main and Service Line Repairs: Water mains and service lines are essential to supply safe, reliable water. In 2024, we replaced 84 service lines and repaired 19 water mains in the City.



Water Pump Station Maintenance: The City monitors and maintains 14 booster pump stations, 7 water turnouts, and 19 storage tanks to successfully capture, treat, and efficiently deliver safe, reliable water.
