FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is a Pioneer Cemetery?

A Pioneer Cemetery is a cemetery that was founded sometime between the 18th and 20th century and is the burial place for the pioneers of the area. It is maintained in its natural state; grasses and wildflowers. The cemetery experiences the natural seasons with green grasses and wildflowers in the winter and spring months and a golden landscape in the summer and fall months.

Who owns and operates the Pleasanton Pioneer Cemetery?

The City of Pleasanton purchased the cemetery in 2007 and owns and operates the cemetery. The Library and Recreation Department oversees the management of the cemetery and may be reached at 925-931-5357 or pioneercemetery@cityofpleasantonca.gov

Are there plots available at the Pleasanton Pioneer Cemetery?

Yes. Casket and cremains burial plots are available in the South Hill West Section.

How do I purchase a plot?

How often is the Cemetery maintained?

General cemetery maintenance is conducted weekly for approximately 15-20 hours per week. City Staff conduct a walk through weekly to identify additional maintenance needs and works with the maintenance crews to address needs that have been identified.

Why is the grass not green year round?

The cemetery is a Pioneer Cemetery so the grass is not irrigated, thus the grass is green only during the wet months of the year.
