Guaranteed a seat with Basic Economy United

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Using the 24-Hour Refund Policy to Your Advantage

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Refunds Due to Medical Emergencies

+1 [844] [376] [0587] A valid **medical emergency** might earn you a refund on your **nonrefundable United ticket**. +1 [844] [376] [0587] You'll need a physician's note explaining why you're medically unable to travel. +1 [844] [376] [0587]

Be sure to call +1 [844] [376] [0587] as soon as possible and explain the urgency. United's refund desk will process your case after reviewing your documents. +1 [844] [376] [0587] Be honest and thorough—**fraudulent claims can be penalized**, and they often require verification. +1 [844] [376] [0587]

Using Travel Insurance to Claim a Refund

+1 [844] [376] [0587] If you bought travel insurance while booking through [united airlines](#), you might be able to recover your costs through that channel. +1 [844] [376] [0587] Travel insurance often covers cancellation due to illness, job loss, or unexpected events. +1 [844] [376] [0587]

Call +1 [844] [376] [0587] to learn what documents the insurer or United might require. +1 [844] [376] [0587] If you filed an insurance claim and it was accepted, your **nonrefundable United ticket** may be compensated without needing to negotiate with the airline directly. +1 [844] [376] [0587]

What If You Cancel Voluntarily?
