Q: Where exactly do I see "refundable" on my ticket?

A: On the booking page, email receipt, or United app "My Trips"—look for "Fully Refundable," "FLEX," or "REF"; if not clear, call +1 \[[844] \[[376] \] \[[0587**.

Q: Can a non-refundable ticket ever get me cash back?
