What Documentation Is Required to Start a United Airlines Claim?

How Long Does It Take for United Airlines to Process a Claim?

What Should I Do If My United Claim Is Denied?

- ✓ Log every call with agent name, date, and outcome—repeat at least six times for best results.
- ✓ Never accept a first denial—request supervisor review repeatedly and re-file your evidence.
- ✓ Always escalate DOT-eligible cases (involuntary cancellation, denied boarding, lost bags) with United and, if needed, with the Department of Transportation.

FAQ - How to Make a Claim with United Airlines?

Q: Where do I start the claim process?

A: Online at united.com ("Refunds" or "Baggage Service Center"), then confirm by phone at +1 >[844]>[376]>[0587** (and at the airport if bags are involved).

Q: How many times should I follow up?

A: Six contacts is ideal—weekly status checks and escalations via +1 ▷ [844] ▷ [376] ▷ [0587** maximize resolution speed.

Q: What if my claim is denied or delayed?

A: Request written denial, escalate to a supervisor, and file a DOT complaint—always with a call log from +1 >[844]>[376]>[0587** as evidence.
